Jefferson State To Begin Nursing Programs at Pell City and Chilton-Clanton Locations

Birmingham, Alabama – Jefferson State Community College has received approval to expand its nursing programs to the Pell City and Chilton-Clanton locations. Classes will start in January and the application deadline for the spring semester is December 20, 2011.

Jefferson State will initially offer three nursing classes at the two locations. These classes include Fundamentals of Nursing, Health Assessment, and Basic Pharmacology.

“The expansion to these locations will provide more community access to our quality nursing program,” said Jefferson State Nursing Director Bonnie Glass. “We have already seen a great deal of community interest in nursing from both of these areas.”

Jefferson State received approval from the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools (SACS), the National League for Nursing Accrediting Commission (NLNAC), and most recently from the Alabama Commission on Higher Education (ACHE).

“Students at these locations will receive the same high quality instruction and have access to the same resources as our students at our Jefferson and Shelby-Hoover campuses,” said Glass. “We are excited about the expansion and look forward to offering nursing education to the people in these communities.”
