APPLICATION AND GUIDELINES

The ***Lillian H. Strother Memorial Veterinary Technology Scholarship*** is awarded Spring semester to a second year student in the Veterinary Technology Program at Jefferson State Community College.

To qualify, a student must:

- have successfully completed a minimum of 25 semester hours of Veterinary Technology courses;
- have and maintain a 3.0 academic average in all Veterinary Technology courses completed;
- demonstrate an interest in small animal and exotics
- demonstrate a need for financial assistance.

The ***Lillian H. Strother Memorial Veterinary Technology Scholarship*** is in the amount of one thousand dollars (\$1,000). Funds will be disbursed to the student in the amount of five hundred (\$500) dollars at the beginning of the spring semester, and the beginning of summer or fall semester. The scholarship may be used for payment of tuition and fees, student supplies, textbooks, and/or living expenses. The scholarship is in addition to any other awards the student may receive.

The recipient of the ***Lillian H. Strother Memorial Veterinary Technology Scholarship*** shall be decided on by the Jefferson State Community College Veterinary Technology Scholarship Committee. Each application will be assessed by the Committee and a top candidate shall be selected by the end of the Fall semester.

Should the recipient of the ***Lillian H. Strother Memorial Veterinary Technology Scholarship*** fail to maintain a 3.0 academic average in all Veterinary Technology courses completed, or withdraws from the Veterinary Technology Program, then the Veterinary Technology Scholarship Committee may re-award any unused portion of the scholarship to another qualified student in the Veterinary Technology Program.
