Refunds/Withdrawals

Jefferson State reserves the right to cancel any course for any reason, including insufficient enrollment. If JSCC cancels a course for which a student is registered, the student will automatically receive a full refund. If the date and/or time of the course is changed by JSCC, the student may request a refund by completing a "Withdrawal Form" within three business days following the date change notification. Jefferson State will not issue full or partial refunds for classes which have been cancelled, nor dismissed early due to inclement weather or other circumstances beyond our control. To withdraw and receive a refund after registering, students must submit a completed "Withdrawal Form" to the Center for Community and Corporate Education at least ten days in advance of the first day of class. Refunds are less an administrative fee of five percent (5%) of the refund amount. Students who register less than ten business days in advance of the first day of class, waive their rights to a refund except for insufficient enrollment.
