COURSE OVERVIEW

This class will cover the OSHA Hazard Communication Standard (29 CFR 1910.1200) otherwise known as the “right-to-know” law. This standard’s concept is that every employee has a need and a right to know about the identities and hazards of the chemicals that they are exposed to at work.
